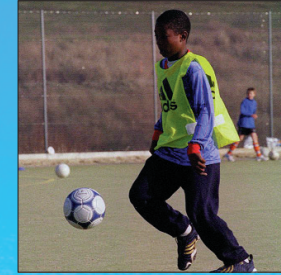

Brighton & Hove Albion FC's award-winning Soccer School Holiday Courses have been running since 1990. Girls and boys aged 6-14, of all abilities, are welcome.

The aim of the courses is for children, whatever their level, to have a great time, make friends, and enjoy and improve their football ability in a safe, structured but fun environment. Children are taught new skills as well as developing existing ones. They are encouraged to appreciate the benefits of teamwork and to develop their self-confidence.

Course Times

All courses run from 10.00 am – 3.00 pm each day. Children should arrive between 9.45 and 9.55 am, and they should be collected promptly at the end of the course at 3.00pm. Venues and dates are as shown opposite.

Course Content

This may vary according to venue/weather, but will usually include warm ups, shooting, dribbling, fun games, small-sided games, tournaments and much more. All children will receive a certificate at the end of the course.

Goalkeeping Courses by John Keeley, BHAFC

For boys and girls aged 8-10 or 11-14, with or without previous experience. Learn the basics or develop your existing goalkeeping skills with first class coaching from John Keeley, the Albion's goalkeeping coach and former Albion goalkeeper. It is advisable to bring goalkeeping gloves and to wear tracksuit bottoms and long sleeves.
