The Albion's summer residential course is held at magnificent Ardingly College, near Haywards Heath in West Sussex, which includes 16 pitches with top quality training surfaces within its grounds.

The course is suitable for outfield players and goalkeepers aged between 9 and 15 who regularly attend a football skills centre or equivalent - or who play for a junior club and want to develop their knowledge and skills in a professional training environment.

The week will include individual technical work, group-based and game-related practices, a question and answer session with Albion players and manager, and lots of fun and games. The programme is run and supervised 24 hours a day by fully-qualified Albion coaches dedicated to providing an enjoyable learning experience in a safe and secure environment.

Booking Conditions

1. Please book early because spaces are extremely limited.
2. All places must be pre-booked and pre-paid by completing and returning the booking form.
3. Cheques are payable to 'Albion in the Community'. Write child's name and course name and your full address on back of cheque.
4. Credit/debit card bookings carry an additional charge of 75p.
5. You will receive booking confirmation and pre-course pack once booking form and payment is received.
6. Deposit of £150 to be received by 30 April 2010 and balance of £165 must be paid in full by 1 July 2010.
7. Cancellation charges apply, as described in 'Cancelling or curtailing your course' above.
8. Albion in the Community reserves the right to change any aspect of the course, including cancelling.

How to book

Having read the Booking Conditions below, complete and return the booking form on the reverse of this leaflet as soon as possible. You will then receive an information pack with all pre course details.

Cancellations

If you find that your child can not take part in the AITC Residential Course and you have to cancel, for whatever reason, your deposit will be forfeited to cover our costs. If we receive your written advice about cancellation or about curtailment of the course on or after

1 July 2010, higher cancellation charges will be made, as follows:

- 33 to 22 days before course start date - 60% of total course price.
- 21 to 15 days before course start date - 75% of total course price.
- 14 to 1 days before course start date - 100% of total course price.
- On or after course start date - 100% of total course price.

The date of effective cancellation is calculated on the day of receipt of written advice by our Football Course Administration Department.

It is recommended you take out insurance to cover the cost of any cancellation or loss. This may be covered by taking out a "holiday" insurance policy. Please contact your insurance broker in advance of booking for advice.
