For keen goalkeepers, aged 7-14, who would like to receive specialist training by qualified goalkeeping coaches. The aim is to develop and improve skills, build confidence and learn new techniques in a safe, structured environment. Children will be taught in age groups. There may be opportunities to advance to Albion Centres of Excellence.

Times 4.30 - 6.00 pm. (Children should arrive at 4.20pm, and be collected promptly at 6pm.)

Course content Includes specific goalkeeping techniques, drills and tactics. On grass unless otherwise stated. All children receive a certificate at the end of the course.

What to bring Training wear, suitable footwear and goalkeeping kit (gloves and track suit bottoms should be worn) Warm/waterproof clothing Shin pads Sun hat / sun block (if sunny) Plenty to drink (not fizzy)

Quality & safety Albion's courses hold the FA Charter Standard award for excellence. All coaches are CRB-checked and hold FA Coaching and First Aid qualifications.

How to book

1. Book early because spaces are limited: **closing date Friday 5 March 2010.**
2. Places must be booked and paid for in advance by completing and returning the booking form.
3. You can pay by cheque or credit card. Make cheques payable to 'Albion In The Community' and write child's name, course code and your full address on reverse. Credit card bookings carry an additional charge of 75p.
4. Bookings on the day not permitted.
5. There is a cancellation fee of £5; the balance will be returned only if at least 10 days' notice given.
6. The Albion reserves the right to change any aspect of the course, including cancelling.
7. Send SAE or phone for confirmation of your place.
8. This course will operate only with a minimum 14 participants.
