What's included

- Four nights' accommodation (single and twin rooms) at Ardingly College

- Full football coaching programme (including Albion legends)
- Evening activities programme, including swimming session
- Q&A sessions with BHAFC professional players
- Albion Residential Course kit (T Shirt, shorts and socks)
- Certificate

What's not included

- Towels
- Additional training clothes, boots and leisure wear

Staff

Staff are carefully selected; all are fully qualified football coaches, CRB checked and are trained in Emergency Aid and Safeguarding Children. Most have several years' experience of providing children's residential football courses.

How to book

Having read the Booking Conditions below, complete and return the booking form on the reverse of this leaflet as soon as possible. You will then receive an information pack with all pre course details.

Cancelling or curtailing your course

If you find that your child can not take part in the AITC Residential Course and you have to cancel, for whatever reason, your deposit will be forfeited to cover our costs. If we receive your written advice about cancellation or about curtailment of the course on or after 29 June 2012, higher cancellation charges will be made, as follows:

- 45 to 22 days before course start date: 60% of course price (£210)
- 21 to 15 days before course start date: 75% of course price (£262)
- 14 to 1 days before course start date – 100% of course price.
- On or after course start date – 100% of course price.

The date of effective cancellation is calculated on the day of receipt of written advice by our Football Course Administration Department.

Insurance

It is recommended you take out insurance to cover the cost of any cancellation or loss. This may be covered by taking out a "holiday" insurance policy. Please contact your insurance broker in advance of booking for advice.

Booking Conditions

- Please book early because spaces are extremely limited.
- All places must be pre-booked and pre-paid by completing and returning the booking form.
- Cheques are payable to 'Albion in the Community'. Write child's name and course name and your full address on back of cheque.
- Credit/debit card bookings carry additional £1 charge.
- You will receive booking confirmation and pre-course pack once booking form and payment is received.
- Deposit of £170 to be received by 26 April 2012 and balance of £179 must be paid in full by 29 June 2012.
- Cancellation charges apply, as described in 'Cancelling or curtailing your course' above.
- Albion in the Community reserves right to change any aspect of the course, including cancelling.
